

## Small Intestine and Large Intestine Instruction Leaflet

### Preparation for the examination

Please do not eat or drink any food or beverages and do not smoke for 6 hours before the examination.

You may take important medications with a small amount of water no later than 3 hours before the examination.

### General information about the examination

- At DZU we do not perform X-ray examinations in pregnant women.
- Please make an appointment for this examination - either by phone, fax or e-mail.
- Please bring the following when you come for the examination:
  - Your **E-card**
  - **Original referral** (it should not have expired)
  - **Previous images / Previous reports** (concerning the area to be examined)
- If you are a minor you must be accompanied by a guardian or should bring your guardian's written consent when you come for the examination.

Please cancel your appointment by phone if you are unable to come - preferably one day before the examination.

Please note that small intestine examinations can take **up to 3 hours** and large intestine examinations can take from **3 to 7 hours**. Patients can eat and drink, and may also leave the center during this time.

Images and reports can be picked up about 30 minutes after the examination.
